I have been meaning to tell you about the day Rhonda was laid to rest was the same day Cris and I said the prayer of salvation at her burial. I do not even know the name of the Reverend/Pastor that was there that day but we are forever thankful that he took the moment that would forever change our lives.

We did not know at first what it actually meant, but as we grow in our faith and understand more of what having salvation and being saved is, we are forever thankful. I know we do not always understand God's plan, but as one of His children went home to be with Him, two of His lost children were saved.

Rosette

I was able to talk with Rosette who stated that this took place seven years ago. I introduced myself to her as the Reverend/Pastor who made the altar call at the gravesite that day. She and her husband are still going strong for Jesus.

Even through times of sadness and pain, God is still close to us. **Psalm 34:18, "The Lord is nigh unto them that are of a broken heart; and saveth such as be of a contrite spirit."**

Rev. Evans-Allen's tears of sadness became tears of joy after learning that her daughter's death resulted in saved lives. Neither Rosette nor her husband knew my name, but it will always be about the name of Jesus, who came to seek and to save the lost.

A TRIP OF A LIFETIME TO SWAZILAND

A few years ago, God placed it on my heart to build a church in Africa. That desire became a reality on July 2-14 of this year. I serve an Ephesians 3:20 God, who does exceeding abundantly above all we can ask or think. He directed me to people who could help make it happen. He supplied the finances to build a church, Christian Liberty Church, in Nhlngano, Swaziland. He put a wonderful team of 43 God-fearing, God-loving, anointed pastors, teachers, ministers, evangelists, psalmists, prayer warriors and photographers from 22 different churches together. He connected me with Missionary Evangelist Ronnie Freeman, from Arkansas, who is doing a great work in Swaziland. It was a very busy time of ministering at Challenge Ministries Teen Challenge and in 7 different churches, conducting a workshop for pastors, lots of children ministry including feeding over 1,200 children, and speaking at schools. Over 2,000 souls were saved. To God be all the glory!

The highlight of the trip was ministering both physically and spiritually to the children. Our hearts were touched to see the way the children responded to us with wonderful smiles and hugs.
