Mission 2023 – Zimbabwe Fact Sheet

Saturday, September 23, 2023 through Wednesday, October 4, 2023

Our Mission

The purpose of this mission trip is found in Matthew 28:19-20 and Acts 1:8.

Entry/Exit Requirements

Passport (US Citizens)

A valid passport is required to enter Zimbabwe and to re-enter the United States. For other countries, entry/exit requirements vary by country. Your passport should be valid for 6 months after the return date and have 2 unstamped pages.

Visa (US Citizens)

A visa is required. Visa will be purchased at the airport in Harare. The cost is \$30 USD. For other countries, entry/exit requirements vary by country.

Age Requirements

As this is an adult mission trip, no child under the age of 16 will be able to participate. Anyone under the age of 18, must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. A permission slip and appropriate documentation will be required for any child under the age of 18 traveling with one parent or a guardian.

Vaccinations

There are no required vaccinations for travel from the United States to Zimbabwe. However, the CDC's website does provide a list of recommended vaccinations. As always, consult your physician.

Ministry Activities

Ministry activities will include preaching/teaching, church services, revivals, evangelism, and women's ministry.

Currency

The currency in Zimbabwe is the Zimbabwean Dollar. Currency exchanges fluctuate greatly, but the exchange rate as of January 18, 2023 was 1 US Dollar to 322 Zimbabwean Dollars.

Electricity

The standard voltage in Zimbabwe is 220 watts. You will need a voltage converter and a plug adapter.

Weather in September

Daily high temperatures range from 77°F to 81°F, rarely falling below 71°F or exceeding 87°F.

Daily low temperatures range from 53°F to 58°F, rarely falling below 47°F or exceeding 63°F.

Dress Code/Clothing

- Bring enough clothing for the entire trip.
- Sunday service attire is required in accordance with the local custom.
- Avoid bare arms, tank tops, low necklines or see through clothing
- Cover tattoos as much as possible and remove facial piercings
- Jewelry should be modest



- Church services
 - Women dresses, skirts (knee length)
 - \circ Men shirt, pants
- Other ministry (visitations, door-to-door, crusades, etc) and Day off
 - Women be prepared to wear both skirts (below the knee) or long pants (including jeans), shirt/t-shirt/sweater. Please do not wear leggings or other tight fitting clothing.
 - Men long pants (including jeans), shirt/t-shirt/sweater

Things to Pack

- Bible
- Journal so you can record what God is doing in your life
- Prescription medicines
- Pepto Bismal, anti-diarrheal medicine, aspirin, etc.
- Spending money for offerings, gifts, tips, souvenirs, etc.
- Insect Repellent Deet is the best
- Sunscreen
- Hat
- Comfortable walking shoes
- Hand Sanitizer
- Wipes for face & hands
- Water Bottle (empty and packed in checked luggage)
- Rain Poncho or umbrella
- Electricity adapter and transformer/voltage converter
- Do not bring expensive or irreplaceable items
- Fanny pack or crossbody bag to keep valuables close to you
- Most important! A godly attitude and an openness to be used by God
