THE CROSS OF CALVARY

When I think of the cross of Calvary, three words come to mind—reflection, removal, and rejoicing.

Reflection

Jesus became human to die for the sins of humanity. He purchased us with his precious blood that he shed. Hebrews 9:22, "And almost all things are by the law purged with blood; and without shedding of blood is no remission." First, the cross reminds me that Christ was without sin. 2 Corinthians 5:21, "For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him." Second, the cross reminds me that the worst sinner can be saved.

Removal

The burdens of sin, sickness, disease, and spiritual death have been lifted. We no longer have to carry them because Jesus paid it all on the cross of Calvary. Jesus said in Matthew 11:28, "Come unto me all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest."

Rejoicing

We rejoice in the freedom we have to live a victorious, abundant, and eternal life with Jesus. When we look in the tomb, we see it is empty. In the words of the angel spoken in Matthew 28:6, "He is not here: for he is risen, as he said...."

Daily we should give thanks to Jesus for leading and loving us out of our sins. You have a choice. Everyone has a choice and on April 12, 1989, I made my choice to receive the finished work of Jesus done on the cross of Calvary.
