Jesus humbled himself and came in the likeness of men. Philippians 2:6-8, Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God: But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men: And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.

Jesus is referred to as "the man Jesus Christ." 1 Timothy 2:5-6, For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus; Who gave himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time.

Jesus came to rescue us from sin. Luke 19:10, For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost.

Jesus is our hope. Hebrews 6:19, Which hope we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and stedfast, and which entereth into that within the veil.
